Petitioner - Rajwinder Kaur Dhaliwal was a contestant for election to the office of Member/ Councillor from Ward No. 21 of Municipal Council, Jagraon, District Ludhiana. The elections were held on 14.2.2021.

By filing the present writ petition, the prayer is for issuance of Mandamus for conducting a fair and impartial enquiry regarding the bogus/ fake voting in elections conducted in Booth Nos. 51 and 52 of Ward No. 21, Jagraon.

At the time of hearing realising that only remedy available is by filing an election petition under Section 74 read with Section 89 of the Punjab State Election Commission Act, 1994, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw the present writ petition with

liberty to file election petition to agitate all the pleas raised in the present writ petition, in accordance with law.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.
