The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.0300 dated 18.11.2019 registered under Sections 120-B, 419, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 472 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Civil Lines, District Amritsar.

The operative part of the order dated 05.04.2021, vide which the petitioner has been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Learned Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case on the basis of disclosure statement of co-accused Sarabjit Singh. The petitioner is not connected with co-accused in any manner and is not involved in commission of any offence. The petitioner is ready to join the investigation.

Notice of motion.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 05.04.2021, has already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on the basis of the affidavit of Assistant Commissioner of Police, North, Amritsar and on instructions from ASI Rajesh Kumar, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 05.04.2021, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
