This petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.455 dated 21.12.2020, under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468, 471, 506 & 120-B Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Sector-31, Faridabad, District Faridabad. The petitioner apprehended his arrest at the hands of Police, in the above FIR.

On 12.03.2021 the following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner, inter-alia, submits that the petitioner herein has been falsely implicated in the instant FIR. It is submitted that the petitioner has only one bank account and the transactions therein would not reflect that he is

beneficiary of any money transferred to his account by his brother.

Notice of motion.

Mr. P.P. Chahar, DAG, Haryana, who is present through the medium of video conferencing, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent—State and seeks time to verify as to who is the holder of the bank account as mentioned in the FIR.

Adjourned to 19.3.2021.

In the meantime, no coercive steps be taken against the petitioner, limited to the next date of hearing.”

Learned State counsel has pointed out that the parties have entered into a compromise and a separate petition bearing No. CRM-M 24111-2021 has been filed for quashing of the FIR.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and it is ordered that in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be admitted to anticipatory bail on his furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
