1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.
2. Prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.12 dated 15.01.2021, registered under Sections 307, 379-B, 458, 323, 427, 506, 148 & 149 IPC IPC at Police Station Jalalabad, District Fazilka, Punjab.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that pursuant to the order of this Court dated 08.04.2021, the petitioner joined investigation, fully cooperated in the same, leading to recovery being made, besides the petitioner was released on ad-interim pre-arrest bail and his custodial interrogation is not required.
4. Learned AAG, Punjab, on instructions from *ASI Bhajan Singh*, confirms that pursuant to the order of this Court dated 08.04.2021, the petitioner joined investigation, fully cooperated in the same leading to recovery of the alleged weapon used in the commission of the offence,

the circumstances, his custodial interrogation is not required.

5. In view of the statement of learned AAG, Punjab, order dated 08.04.2021 passed by this Court, is made absolute. The petitioner shall abide by the conditions enumerated in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

6. Petition stands ***disposed of*** in the aforementioned terms.
