The matter has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of COVID-19.

This is a petition under Section 482 Cr. P.C. for issuance of directions to respondent No. 2 to direct the official respondents No. 4 to 6 not to interfere in the peaceful life of the petitioner and his family members.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that despite there being no case against the petitioner, the police is repeatedly visiting the house of the petitioner.

At this stage, learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Joginder Singh, has informed this Court that FIR No. 172 dated 22.10.2020 under Sections 302, 120-B, 148 and 149 IPC is registered at Police Station Sadar, Malot against the

petitioner. He has also been nominated as an accused on 08.03.2021 for the offence under Section 212 of IPC.

In view of the aforesaid fact that the petitioner has been nominated in the FIR, the prayer, so made, in the present petition cannot be acceded to.
