The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing in the light of the pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Prayer in the present petition is for extension of the period of parole of the petitioner for a period of three weeks to facilitate the surgery management of his wife and for post surgery care.

Reply in the petition by way of affidavit of Deputy Superintendent, District Jail, Gurugram has been circulated in the Court through e-mail by the learned State counsel today and the same is taken on record. Copy thereof has already been supplied to the learned counsel opposite.

Learned State counsel informs that wife of the petitioner is presently residing with her parents and the surgery would be required after two weeks.

The petitioner earlier has already availed parole numerous times and has never misused the concession thereof. His earlier parole of three weeks for the purpose in question is going to expire on 13.03.2021.

Considering the above, we feel that the petitioner being the husband is under obligation to make arrangement of the funds and to accord emotional support to his wife.

In the circumstances, we are inclined to accept the prayer made. Accordingly, the instant petition is allowed and the parole of the petitioner is extended for three weeks on his furnishing indemnity bonds with two local sureties to the satisfaction of the competent authority/Duty Magistrate. The petitioner shall surrender before the jail authorities on the date and time to be noticed by the releasing Court/Duty Magistrate.
