The Court has been convened through video conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

Through the instant petition, the petitioners seek anticipatory bail in case FIR No.05 dated 14.01.2019 registered under Section 420 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Kacha Pacca, District Tarn Taran.

On 25.02.2020, following order was passed:-

“It is submitted that allegations against the petitioner are that even though she was owner of 04 kanals 18 marlas of land, but she executed two separate sale deeds dated 11.09.2015 whereby she sold 03 kanals 14 marlas of land each to the complainant-Satnam Singh and his son Gurchet Singh. Counsel submitted that sale deed was alleged to had been executed on 11.09.2015 whereas the present complaint was submitted on 02.09.2019 on the basis of which FIR was

registered on 14.01.2020.

Notice of motion for 28.04.2020.

Meanwhile, the petitioner shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, she shall be admitted to interim bail on her furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting Investigating Officer. She shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Counsel for the petitioner submits that besides the delay in lodging of the FIR, the dispute is purely civil in nature and has deliberately been given a criminal colour to pressurize the petitioner.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Rajpal Singh submits that petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation. He has further instructions to state that petitioner is not involved in any other criminal case.

In view of the above facts, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 25.02.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
