By way of the instant petition, the petitioners have sought the indulgence of this Court for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to regularize their services with effect from the respective dates of completion of five years' service, on contractual basis, by them and to grant them all the consequential benefits accordingly with interest thereon @ 18% per annum and/or for directing the respondents to grant the benefit of the recommendations of the 7th Pay Commission along with the arrears of salary and the interest thereon at the above said rate, while averring that they have become entitled to the regularization of their services as well as to the grant of salary as payable to the regular employees and though they have already served legal notice dated 19.02.2021(Annexure P-7) to respondent No.2 in this regard, but the same has not yet been decided.

Mr. SS Pannu, DAG, Haryana, has joined the proceedings on behalf of all the respondents in this case in pursuance of the copies of this petition having been sent to the respondent-State in advance.

Heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners would be satisfied in case a direction is given to respondent No.2 to look into and deal with/decide their said legal notice within some specific time frame.

Learned State counsel has no objection for the same.

Keeping in view the above-discussed limited prayer of learned counsel for the petitioners and without commenting upon the merits of the matter in hand, the instant petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Director General, Secondary Education Haryana-cum-Vice Chairman AAROHI EBB Model Shools, to look into and deal with/decide the said legal notice of the petitioners dated 19.02.2021(Annexure P-7), in accordance with law/relevant rules, by passing a speaking order thereon, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

This petition stands disposed of accordingly.
