Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.58 dated 10.12.2020, under Section 498-A IPC, at Police Station Women District Police Commissionerate, Amritsar.

The Hon'ble Coordinate Bench vide his detailed order dated 12.03.2021, directed the petitioner to send an amount of Rs.50,000/- towards medical expenses within a week in the account of the complainant through RTGS and also directed that after 40 days of delivery of the child, both the parties would appear before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre, Amritsar. On the basis of the observations made, arrest of the petitioner was stayed till next date.

Learned counsel for the petitioner clearly submits before the Court that an order has not been complied with and this Court may pass an appropriate order.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, the prayer made for an extraordinary relief under Section 438 Cr.P.C cannot be granted as the conduct of the petitioner is not at all satisfactory.

No ground is made out to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Petition stands dismissed.
