The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 261 dated 19.12.2019 under Sections 323, 34, 354-B IPC registered at Police Station Kotbhai, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has joined the investigation. It is also contended that nothing is to be recovered from the petitioner.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Karamjeet Singh, submits that in terms of order dated 12.03.2021, the petitioner has already joined the investigation and he is not required for the custodial interrogation.

In view of the facts that the petitioner is not required for custodial interrogation and has joined the investigation, without

commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 12.03.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
