This is a petition for regular bail filed on behalf of the petitioner under Section 439 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.180 dated 01.08.2020, under Sections 307, 323 & 324 of the IPC (Section 326 of the IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Sadar Kapurthala, District Kapurthala.

[2]. Reply not filed on behalf of the State in compliance of the last order, but Ld. State Counsel submits that the petitioner has been in custody for more than one year, since 03.08.2020.

[3]. After completion of investigation, Challan has already been submitted against the petitioner and Charges have also been framed, but so far not even the 1st out of 15 Prosecution Witnesses cited has been examined. There appears to be no record of petitioner's involvement in any other criminal case.

[4]. In these circumstances, without commenting any further on the merits of the present case as a whole, and considering the fact that no useful

purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in detention for an indefinite period, his prayer for regular bail is allowed and he is ordered to be released on regular bail, subject to appropriate terms and conditions to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
