The petitioners are seeking a direction to the trial Court to expedite the trial.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners are unwell and, therefore, the trial be expedited.

Heard.

The FIR was registered on 07.06.2019 under Sections 406 and 498-A IPC. It is apparent that there is no material on record to indicate that the petitioners are unwell, therefore, at this stage, I do not find it just to issue a direction to the trial Court to decide the trial expeditiously as several other cases wherein the accused are in custody would require priority. The petitioners are on bail.

The petition stands dismissed.

Although there is no material to indicate that the petitioners are unwell, however, in case the petitioners prefer an application for exemption before the trial Court with relevant medical documents, the same shall be considered by the trial Court in accordance with law.
