The instant Petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking Anticipatory Bail in case FIR No.0018 dated 16.02.2021 registered under Sections 22 (A) & 29 of the NDPS Act No. 61 of 1985 at Police Station Bajakhana, District Faridkot.

Learned State counsel submits that the name of the petitioner had transpired from the disclosure statement of co-accused and as such her custodial interrogation is not required at this stage.

In view of the aforesaid submissions, the prayer for anticipatory bail is allowed and she shall be released on bail subject to her furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, she shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr. P.C.
