The cases have been taken up for hearing through
video conferencing.

Vide this order, CRM-M No.8081 of 2020 and CRM-M

No.9727 of 2020 are being disposed of. Since both the cases have arisen out of one FIR, therefore, the common facts are being culled out from CRM-M No.8081 of 2020.

Petitioner(s) seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.295 dated 20.12.2019 registered under Section 304 IPC, Police Station Sirhind, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

After issuance of notice of motion, petitioner(s) was directed to join investigation along with interim directions.

Learned counsel for the petitioner(s) submits that in case of co-accused Madanjit Singh @ Hally i.e. CRM-M No.3819 of 2020 decided on 02.03.2020, it was recorded that Madanjit Singh @ Hally had allegedly chased the vehicle of the deceased along with others up to a certain distance. Thereafter, vehicle of the deceased was chased by a Bolero jeep. Madanjit Singh @ Hally was not named in the original version. In the investigation conducted by the Special Investigating Team, his role came to fore that his friend, namely, Paramjit Singh @ Monu came to him and by boarding his Swift car, Madanjit Singh @ Hally saw Corolla car of the deceased and he raised some suspicion with regard to some persons with liquor boxes in the car of the deceased. Madanjit Singh @ Hally and petitioner Sukhwinder Singh (in CRM-M No. 9727 of 2020) boarded their Bolero jeep and started chasing the car of the deceased. Swift car of Madanjit Singh @ Hally was hit by the car of the deceased and thereafter, there was no chasing by Swift car.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from DSP Deepak Singh, submits that after investigation of the case, challan has already been submitted on 27.07.2020 and the petitioner(s) was duly joined in the investigation and he is no

more required for further investigation of the case.

In view of aforesaid position, the interim orders dated 02.03.2020 (passed in **CRM-M No.8081 of 2020**) and 05.03.2020 (passed in **CRM-M No.9727 of 2020**) are made absolute. Petitioners shall keep on appearing before the trial Court on each and every date.

Petitions stand disposed of.
