ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 26 dated 25.02.2021, under Sections 3, 4, 5, 5 (A) and 8 of the Immoral Traffic (Prevention) Act, 1956, registered at Police Station Sadar Rupnagar, District Rupnagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it is alleged that the petitioner had taken a 'dhaba' on lease where immoral activities were taking place. He, however, contends that the husband and brother-in-law of the petitioner have been arrested. He also contends that the petitioner is 30 years of age with two minor children and she is not involved in any other criminal case.

This Court, by the order dated 09.03.2021, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of her arrest, she was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Kamal Kishore, states that the petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the above, especially when the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 09.03.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. She shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
