This is the second petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0042 dated 07.05.2018 under Sections 406, 498-A of the IPC, 1860 registered at Police Station Women Cell, Sector-17, Chandigarh.

On a pointed query put to the learned counsel for the petitioner as to what were the changed circumstances pursuant to the dismissal of the previous petition filed under Section 438 of the Cr.P.C, 1973 on 05.02.2020 by this Court which would warrant acceptance of the instant petition, he has failed to satisfy this Court qua the same. No doubt that successive bail petitions may be filed by an accused but only if there is any change in circumstances. In the instant case no substantial change in circumstances as already noticed above has been brought forth subsequent to the dismissal of the previous petition on 05.02.2020. In the circumstances, reconsideration of

the prayer for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner would amount to review of the earlier order passed by this Court which is not permissible in law. Resultantly, the instant petition is hereby dismissed.
