[1]. This is a petition for anticipatory bail filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. on behalf of the petitioner in case FIR No.106, dated 04.05.2019, under Sections 307, 506 & 120-B of the IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Bawal, District Rewari.

[2]. Ld. State counsel, on specific instructions from Sub Inspector – Sube Singh, submits that in spite of the direction passed on the last date, the petitioner did not join investigation on the designated date, i.e., 16.12.2020, and the Motorcycle in question is still to be recovered.

[3]. Ld. Counsel for the petitioner, however, submits that the petitioner did join the investigation. When asked to furnish adequate proof of having done so, as specifically directed by this Court in the previous order, the petitioner's counsel is, however, unable to furnish any such proof.

[4]. In such circumstances, no further indulgence deserves to be shown towards the petitioner and his prayer for anticipatory bail is, therefore, dismissed and interim protection earlier granted to him accordingly stands withdrawn.
