The petitioners have invoked the jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* for issuance of directions to the respondents to disburse the compensation with all statutory benefits to the petitioner in lieu of the acquisition of the land of the petitioner comprising in Khewat No.495/434 Khatoni No.72/73, Khasra No.86 Kila No.8 Min (1-8), ½ share of 9/2/1 (2-0) and 9/1/2 (2-12), total measuring 5 Kanal 0 Marla to the extent of the share of the petitioner situated in the revenue estate of village Harsaru, Tehsil and District

Gurugram have been acquired vide notification u/s 4 followed by the declaration u/s 6 of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894, equivalent to Section 11 of the Act No.30 of 2013 published in the Haryana Government Gazette vide award No.56 dated 23.12.2016 (Annexure P-6) passed by Land Acquisition Collector vide which respondents have acquired land and possession has been taken by the respondents.
