AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

Due to COVID-19 situation, the Court is convened through video conference.

This is a petition seeking quashing of FIR No 11 dated 18.2.2020, under Sections 409, 420, 120-B, 419, 465, 467, 468, 471, 477-A IPC, Sections 7 and 13 of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988, Sections 66 and 66-D of Information Technology Act, 2000 registered at Police Station Tarsikka, District Amritsar (Rural).

On an earlier date, the court was informed that a discharge application is pending. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in the reply filed to discharge application, it is pleaded that there is no sanction was received.
