Prayer in this petition is for protecting the life and liberty of the petitioners and issuing directions to respondent Nos. 4 and 5 not to interfere in the life of the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioner No. 1, who is aged about 37 years, was married to respondent No. 4 Rajinder Singh on 23.04.2004 and she is having two minor children of the said wedlock.

Learned counsel further submits that respondent No. 4, in order to earn livelihood, is presently residing in Malaysia and is not properly taking care of petitioner No. 1 and minor children.

Learned counsel further submits that petitioner No. 1 and petitioner No. 2, who is a widower and having three children, have now decided to live together and on that account, respondent No. 4 is creating problems in the peaceful life of the petitioners.

On the face of it, it is a matrimonial dispute between petitioner

No. 1 and respondent No. 4 and a divorce petition is also stated to be pending between them at Family Court, Sangrur.

Petitioner No. 1 has a remedy to approach the competent Court under the Domestic Violence Act or she may seek maintenance for herself or her minor children or she can approach the Illaqua Magistrate for registration of FIR under Section 406/498-A IPC, if so advised. It is not the job of the police to find out a solution to the matrimonial discord of petitioner No.1 and respondent No. 4.

Accordingly, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed with liberty to petitioners to avail their alternative remedy in accordance with law.
