By way of present writ petition, the petitioner seeks directions to respondent No.3 to grant earned leave to the petitioner, for which he has applied on 11.12.2020 for his treatment as he is suffering from various ailments. Further, salary due from October 2020 onwards is also sought.

The case of the petitioner is that he is working as ASI/LR in Punjab Police, Kapurthala. He is suffering from various ailments, as per the prescriptions dated 05.08.2020 and 18.08.2020. It is the case of the petitioner that he had applied for earned leave for 160 days vide application dated 11.12.2020 and in pursuance of the same, he was asked to appear before respondent No.3 and his application was not entertained. A legal notice dated 17.12.2020 (Annexure P-2) has also been served upon the respondents for necessary action.

Notice of motion.

Ms.Simran Grewal, AAG Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Keeping in view the controversy, since the decision as such is yet to be taken on the legal notice, this Court is of the opinion that reply on such an issue be not called for.

Accordingly, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to take a decision on the legal notice dated 17.12.2020 (Annexure P-2), by passing a speaking order within a period of ten days from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. If the petitioner is not entitled for the said benefits, the petitioner be informed by passing a speaking order and supplying a copy of the order to the petitioner.
