Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of appropriate direction to the trial Court for speedy trial in case bearing No.CHI/512/2017 CNR No.HRJR03-001672-2017 titled as “State Versus Manish and others” in FIR No.0079 dated 25.05.2017 under Sections 354, 377, 498A, 506 of IPC, Women Police Station Jhajjar, District Jhajjar.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the dispute being matrimonial in nature, at this stage, he has the instructions to state that the trial Court may be directed to refer the matter for mediation where amicable settlement may take place.

In view of the statement so made by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has shown inclination to have recourse of mediation, the learned Magistrate shall make an endeavour to refer the matter for mediation so that some amicable settlement may take place.

As regard to the prayer made by counsel for the petitioner regarding exemption from personal apparance of the petitioner, as she is an old lady, let the petitioner approach the trial Court for such relief and this Court has no doubt in its mind that the same would be sympathetically considered.
