Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.308 dated 13.10.2020 under Sections 324, 506, 148, 149 IPC and Section 326 IPC (added later on), registered at Police Station Lopoke, Amritsar.

While staying arrest of the petitioner, following order was passed by this Court on 12.03.2021: -

“...Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the occurrence took place on 28.09.2020 and FIR in question came to be registered only on 13.10.2020 i.e. after a delay of 15 days. As per FIR, the injured was discharged by the doctor on the next day by giving medical assistance. Petitioner is alleged to have given sickle blow on the left leg of the complainant. Cause of

grievance/enmity was that on 11.06.2020, son of the complainant was beaten and drowned in the water by the petitioner and others for which a complaint was made to the police.

Learned counsel further contends that the police did not find any incriminatory allegation against the petitioner and others in respect of incident leading to death of son of the complainant...”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from the Investigating Officer, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioner is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 12.03.2021 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
