ARVIND SINGH SANGWAN, J. (Oral)

This is a petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to respondent No. 2-the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar to decide the representation (Annexure P-3) dated 25.01.2021 given by the petitioner and take appropriate legal action against the private respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner and respondent No.4 to 6 started a business jointly in which the petitioner has made the investment of 70% and respondent No.4 to 6 have made the investment of 30%, however, later on, the income was taken by respondent Nos.4 to 6 and now they are not giving the due share to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that in this regard, the petitioner has given a representation (Annexure P-3) dated 25.01.2021 to the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar, however, the same has not been decided so far.

On the face of it, the dispute between the parties is regarding rendition of account or payment of the money, for which the petitioner has a remedy to file a civil suit to recover the amount, if any, and it is not the job of the police to get the money recovered for the petitioner.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.

However, liberty is granted to petitioner to avail his alternative remedy in accordance with law.
