The hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

This is the second petition for grant of bail to the petitioner, pending trial in a criminal case arising from FIR No.77, dated 23.06.2017, registered under Section 302/201/216/34 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959, at Police Station Sector 9-A, Gurugram, District Gurugram.

The learned senior counsel, after arguing for some time, prays for permission to withdraw the petition. However, he submits that the petitioner is in custody for the last 4 years and 2 months, therefore, the trial of the case be ordered to be expedited.

It has been noticed that the deposition of all the private witnesses have been recorded. Now the statements of the official witnesses are required to be recorded by the prosecution.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the learned trial court is requested to make sincere endeavours for concluding the trial positively within a period of 4 months.

In view therefore, accordingly the present petition is disposed of.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
