Case taken up through video conferencing.

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 0091 dated 12.12.2020, under Sections 308, 323, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Sudhar, District Ludhiana Rural.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the injuries, which have been attributed to the petitioner, are on the leg and elbow of the injured and simple in nature. He also contends that the petitioner is 27 years of age and does not have criminal antecedents.

This Court, by the order dated 12.03.2021, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Puran Singh, states that although the petitioner has joined investigation but recovery is yet to be effected.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 12.03.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
