The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, in case FIR No. 117, dated 18.12.2017, lodged under Sections 406, 498-A of IPC, registered at Police Station Women, Chandigarh (Annexure P-1).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 03rd April, 2018, the petitioner has joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency. He further submits that during the pendency of the instant petition, the parties have arrived at an amicable settlement and have also filed a joint petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, wherein, their first motion statements have been recorded.

Learned State counsel assisted by learned counsel for the complainant, does not dispute the submissions made by learned counsel for

the petitioner. Learned State counsel further on instructions from ASI Dalveer Singh, has submitted that the petitioner has joined investigation and he is no longer required for further investigation, much less, custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 03rd April, 2018, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
