This matter is being taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to the outbreak of pandemic, COVID-19.

The petitioner seeks quashing of termination order dated 06.01.2019 (Annexure P-1), whereby services of the petitioner with respondent no.8 – M/s. L & T Construction, admittedly not an instrumentality of the State, have been terminated.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is unable to deny that an efficacious alternate remedy is available to the petitioner.

In this view of the matter, no ground is made out for interference in this writ petition.

Writ petition is accordingly dismissed. Needless to say the petitioner is at liberty to avail remedy/remedies as may be available to him in accordance with law.
