The hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

Through this writ petition, the petitioner prays for issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari, to quash the impugned order dated 31.12.2020, placing the petitioner under suspension from service. The petitioner has also prayed for direction to release the salary and subsistence allowance.

Learned counsel representing the petitioner has very fairly stated that the subsistence allowance has already been released to the petitioner and regular inquiry has also been completed. Hence, he prays for disposal of the writ petition with a direction to the respondents to decide the matter finally, within a stipulated time frame.

Learned State counsel has informed the Court that as per his information, the proceedings in the regular inquiry have been completed, however, the final report has not been received.

Be that as it may be. Keeping in view the aforesaid facts of

the case, it is considered appropriate to direct the respondents to finalize the disciplinary action, if any, against the petitioner within a period of 45 days from the date the report from the inquiry officer is received.

With the aforesaid observations, the writ petition is disposed of.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
