Prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.0006 dated 28.01.2021, registered under Sections 379 IPC and Section 21 Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulation), 1957 at Police Station Verowal, District Tarn Taran, Punjab.
