Present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari for quashing of adverse remarks in the ACRs of petitioner for the years 2013-14 and 2014-15 (P-13 and P-14 respectively) on the ground of *malafide*.

After arguing for some time, learned Counsel for the petitioner, on instructions, states that instead of pressing the present petition on merits, his client would be satisfied in case representations dated 22.06.2015 (P-17) and 20.09.2018 (P-18) are considered and decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to the aforesaid limited extent.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Akshita Chauhan, AAG Punjab, who is present through Video-Conference, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection against the innocuous prayer of the petitioner.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without going into the merits of the controversy, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to respondents No.1 to consider and decide the aforesaid representations (P-17 and

P-18) in accordance with law by passing speaking order expeditiously, but not later than 31.10.2021.
