This second petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of bail pending trial in case FIR No.3 dated 14.01.2011, registered under Sections 302, 148 and 149 of IPC, at Police Station Khem Karan, District Tarn Taran.

Custody certificate dated 23.11.2021 filed by learned State counsel in the Court is taken on record.

It has been pointed out the State counsel that there were 22 witnesses of the prosecution. One of them has expired. Twenty witnesses of the prosecution have already been examined and only one witness is left to be examined. The prosecution shall make earnest effort to examine the said witness as well; on the next date fixed before the trial Court.

In view of the above, this Court does not find it appropriate to interfere so as to grant bail to the petitioner pending trial, at this stage.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
