The hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

This is the second petition for grant of bail pending trial in FIR No.55, dated 13.03.2019, registered under Section 20 of NDPS Act, 1985, at Police Station Sadar Narwana, District Jind.

The first petition was dismissed as withdrawn on 10.07.2019. As per the case of prosecution, two boys were intercepted by the police party and found having 5kg charas. 2.300 kg was allegedly recovered from the hatch-pack bag of the petitioner whereas 2.700 was allegedly recovered from the hatch-pack bag of Mehar Singh. The quantity falls in the commercial category. The trial Court has already framed charges and fixed the case for

prosecution evidence.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, this Bench is not inclined to grant concession of bail.

Disposed of.

However, since the petitioner is in custody for nearly 2 years and 4 months therefore, the leaned trial Court is requested to expedite the conclusion of the trial.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
