This Criminal Writ Petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been moved by petitioner for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing official respondents to protect the life and liberty of petitioner at the hands of private respondents No.4 and 5 and to take action on representation dated 18.02.2021 (Annexure P-1) and dated 08.03.2021 (Annexure P-3), in accordance with law.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that petitioner has already made representations on 18.02.2021 and 08.03.2021 to Station House Officer, Police Station Civil Lines, Batala, District Gurdaspur, copy of which are available on the file as Annexures P/1 and P/3 respectively, but still no action has been taken.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only.

At the asking of Court, Mr. Mehardeep Singh, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3. Complete copy of paper book has been supplied to him.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2 – Senior Superintendent of Police, District Gurdaspur, to look into and decide representations dated 18.02.2021 (Annexure P/1) and 08.03.2021 (Annexure P-3) in accordance with law by passing speaking order and that too within six weeks positively from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
