The prayer in the present petition is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.282 dated 07.10.2020 under Sections 308, 325, 323, 341 and 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Bhawanigarh, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in custody since 23.01.2021 and the challan has been presented before the trial Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that as per the allegations in the FIR, which is a version and a cross version case as even from the petitioner side two persons have suffered injuries. As per the MLR, Annexures P-4 and P-5, the allegations against the petitioner are that he has caused simple injuries on the complainant side and the petitioner has already filed a complaint (Annexure P-6) before the competent authority.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the allegations against the petitioner are that he has caused two simple injuries on

the complainant side and in this regard the petitioner has relied upon an affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division, Bhawanigarh, District Sangrur which was filed in CRM-M-36144-2020. The said petition was filed before this Court by the petitioner alongwith others for grant of anticipatory bail.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that as per this affidavit, the police during verification has found that the petitioner-Kuldip Singh has caused injuries Nos.1 and 3 on the complainant side and both the injuries were declared as simple in nature.

Learned State counsel as well as learned counsel for the complainant has not disputed the aforesaid situation. It is also not disputed that the case is a version and a cross version and injuries caused by the petitioner are simple in nature.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties and the allegations against the petitioner and the nature of injuries, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on her furnishing of bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of concerned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.
