The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.210 dated 11.09.2020, registered under Section 18 of the NDPS Act at Police Station Lohian, District Jalandhar.

The operative part of the order dated 16.03.2021, vide which interim anticipatory bail has been granted to the petitioner, is reproduced as under:-

“...Learned counsel for the petitioner relies upon the order dated 29.01.2021 passed in CRM-M-37917, 34992 & 21864-2020 as well as the order dated 03.03.2021 passed in CRM-M-9856-2021 and submits that three co-accused of the petitioner have been granted the concession of interim bail and vide order dated 05.03.2021 passed in CRM-M-10378-2021, one another co-accused Swaran Singh has been granted the concession of interim anticipatory bail in view of the aforesaid orders.

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that, in pursuance to the order dated 16.03.2021, the petitioner has appeared before the Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 16.03.2021 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
