Petitioner has approached this Court with a prayer for considering his claim for grant of parole. Challenge has also been posed to the order dated 24.08.2020 (Annexure P-1), which was passed by the District Magistrate, Sangrur District, Sangrur, declining the prayer of the petitioner for grant of parole.

Counsel asserts that the order relates to the request made by the petitioner for grant of agriculture parole but the impugned order does not indicate so, rather it deals with the request of the petitioner on the pretext of corona virus pandemic.

Learned counsel for the State, on the other hand, asserts that assuming the request of the petitioner was for grant of agriculture parole, which has been declined vide order dated 24.08.2020 (Annexure P-1), the same was for a particular crop, period for which, as of now, may have gone.

The present writ petition is disposed of with an observation that in case the petitioner now approaches the competent authority for grant of agriculture parole by way of an application, the same shall be considered and a decision taken thereon within a period of three weeks of submission of such application for grant of agriculture parole.
