Case heard by video conference.

By this petition, the petitioner seeks the concession of 'anticipatory bail', upon FIR no.0068, dated 28.04.2020, having been registered at Police Station Tibba, Ludhiana, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under the provisions of Sections 188/306/120-B of the IPC.

The petitioner having been ordered to be admitted to interim upon him joining investigation, with it made clear that if the investigating officer did not join him in the investigation he would report to the *Ilaqa* Magistrate concerned, who would then summon the investigating officer and ensure that the petitioner is joined in the investigation, learned State counsel submits, on instructions, that he has not joined investigation, despite the aforesaid order.

Upon query to learned counsel for the petitioner he submits that the petitioner in fact is not responding to even his phone calls.

That being so, without making any comment on the actual merits of the case, I would see no reason for this petition to be continued, which is consequently dismissed, with the interim order vacated.
