This is the 3rd petition for anticipatory bail preferred by the petitioner. The first petition bearing CRM-M-38924-2020 was dismissed as withdrawn on 25.11.2020 and the second petition bearing CRM-M-2112-2021 was dismissed as withdrawn on 15.01.2021.

Heard through video conferencing.

The allegations against the petitioner are that he had caused a *datar* blow on the head of the complainant. The petitioner along with other accused were armed with weapons and had caused serious injuries to the complainant. Therefore, as the petitioner has been attributed an injury on the head of the complainant with a *datar*, I do not find any ground to grant the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner especially when two previous petitions for anticipatory bail had been dismissed.

Consequently, the petition stands dismissed.
