The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.64 dated 28.04.2019 registered under Section 22 of NDPS Act, at Police Station Sadar, Kapurthala, District Kapurthala.

Notice of motion was issued on the premise that interim bail was granted to the petitioner till receipt of FSL report. FSL report is still awaited but challan stands presented. Trial Court was informed on 16.12.2019 and an order was passed for attaching the remand paper along with challan, but no specific date was given. Petitioner was present on 06.12.2019 in the remand proceedings but he was not shown marked present in the main case and non-bailable warrants were issued after cancelling the interim bail of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in

pursuance of order dated 27.02.2020, the petitioner has already appeared before the trial Court on 30.04.2021 and thereafter, petitioner has been appearing before the trial Court regularly and this fact can be ascertained from the order dated 30.04.2021 passed by Judge Special Court Kapurthala.

The factual position of the case could not be disputed by learned State counsel that challan stands presented on 29.11.2019 and the case is fixed for 30.07.2021.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Mangal Singh further submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation of the case.

In view of aforesaid position, order dated 27.02.2020 is made absolute. However, petitioner shall keep on appearing before the trial Court on each and every date.

Petition stands disposed of.
