Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail in FIR No.43 dated 21.02.2020 under Sections 148, 149, 307, 427, 120-B IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Urban Estate, Hisar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per allegations in the FIR, registered at the instance of complainant Rakesh Pandit, when I reached near house of Surender Kaushik, in the meantime, petitioner Raman, while riding along with Aman Yadav and one more person, came in front of his car and started firing with intention to kill him. One bullet hit on his chin and chest. It is further submitted that the petitioner has been falsely implicated on account of some previous enmity.

Learned State counsel has filed the custody certificate dated

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25.04.2021 in the Court today and submitted that the petitioner is habitual offender and is involved in number of other criminal cases at different police stations.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, I find no ground to grant regular bail tot he petitioner.

Faced with the above, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition at this stage.

Dismissed as withdrawn at this stage.
