Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

As per office report, respondent No.2 has been served through its Manager, but none has appeared on its behalf.

Through this petition, the petitioners seek anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.267 dated 28.08.2019 registered under Sections 406, 420 IPC (Section 201 IPC added later on) at Police Station Rohtak Civil Lines, District Rohtak.

Vide order dated 27.02.2020 passed by a Coordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioners were granted *ad-interim* anticipatory bail and directed to join the investigation.

Thereafter, in view of the fact that petitioners No.2 and 3 had been granted regular bail by the trial Court, the present petition qua them was ordered to have become infructuous, vide order dated 27.07.2021 passed by the Coordinate Bench.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that pursuant to the order dated 27.02.2020 passed by the Coordinate Bench, petitioner No.1 has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on the instructions from SI Amit, submits that petitioner No.1 has joined the investigation and is now not required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 27.02.2020 granting interim bail to petitioner No.1, is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
