It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner and her child are being continuously harassed and tortured by the private respondents, who are her husband and in-laws' family.

On the asking of Court, Mr. Luvinder Sofat, A.A.G., Punjab, who has joined the proceedings through video conferencing, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

In the wake of the limited prayer of the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Assistant

Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana to look into the grievance of the petitioner and take appropriate steps, if any required, under the provisions of law. However, if respondent No.2 does not find any substance or merit in the allegations levelled by her, then the petitioner shall be duly informed as per the parameters laid down by Hon'ble the Supreme Court in ***Lalita Kumari vs Govt. of Uttar Pradesh & ors. 2013(4) RCR (Criminal) 979.***
