The petitioner-mother seeks setting aside of directions issued by the learned Additional Principal Judge, Family Court, Gurugram, directing her to produce the minor children before a Psychological Evaluation Board constituted by All India Institute of Medical Sciences, New Delhi under directions of the Court.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner at length, what emerges is that the petitioner is feeling inconvenienced in taking the children for psychological evaluation as she and the children are made to wait for hours together.

The next date fixed by the Medical Board is 1.4.2021 at 8.30 a.m. as is evident from communication dated 26.2.2021 (Annexure P-11). Thus, the revision petition is disposed of with a direction to the concerned Medical Board to start their evaluation latest by 9 a.m. on the said date. Unnecessary delay in commencing the evaluation shall be avoided at all costs and efforts shall be made to conclude the same on 1.4.2021, itself.
