Case has been taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing.

This petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been moved for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of petitioners at the hands of respondents No.4 to 13.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contended that petitioners have already made representation on 10.03.2021 to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar Rural, copy of which is available on the file as Annexure P/3, but still no action has been taken.

Notice of motion confined to respondents No.1 to 3 only.

At the asking of Court, Mr. Mehardeep Singh, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3. Complete copy of paper book has been supplied to him.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar Rural, to look into and decide representation dated 10.03.2021 (Annexure P/3) in accordance with law by passing speaking order and that too within four weeks positively from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
