Learned counsel for the petitioners has argued that the petitioners are known to each other, who fell in love and decided to marry. However, respondent No.4, who is father of petitioner No.1 was against their relationship. On 11.03.2021, petitioners solemnized marriage at Gurudwara as per Sikh rites. As per the pleadings, after the marriage of the petitioners, they are receiving threats from respondent No.4. He has invited the attention of the Court to Annexure P-4 to contend that a representation dated 11.03.2021 has already been filed to to Senior Superintendent of Police, Barnala, District Barnala, however, till date no action has been taken by the said officer. He prays that appropriate direction be issued.

During the course of hearing, it is not disputed by learned counsel that the representation dated 11.03.2021 (Annexure P-4), was sent to

respondent No.2 through postal receipt dated 12.03.2021 and the petition was also filed on the same date.

After hearing, learned counsel for the petitioners, this Court finds that even the representation filed by the petitioners did not reach the office of respondent No.2 and the petitioners filed the petition on the very same day and no time was given to the authority for redressal of their grievance. Apart from it, the representation submitted by the petitioners to respondent No.2 does not reveal the manner and mode of alleged threat extended to the petitioners.

Resultantly, this Court does not find it to be a fit case for exercise of extra ordinary writ jurisdiction.

Dismissed.
