1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.
2. Prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.179 dated 07.08.2019, registered under Sections 452, 323 and 34 IPC, 1860, at Police Station Canal Colony, District Bathinda.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that pursuant to the order of this Court dated 27.02.2020, the petitioner joined investigation, fully cooperated with the police, was released on ad interim pre arrest bail and that her custodial interrogation is not required.

4. In view of the statement of the learned AAG, Punjab, order dated 27.02.2020, passed by this Court, is made absolute. The petitioner shall abide by the terms and conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
