Heard through video conferencing.

This is the third petition preferred by the petitioner seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 62 dated 17.08.2019, under Sections 324, 323, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 ('IPC' - for short) (Section 326 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Tibber, District Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that there is no X-ray report which would indicate that the injury caused by the petitioner is grievous.

Heard.

This is the third petition for anticipatory bail. The first petition bearing CRM-M No. 45173 of 2019 was dismissed as withdrawn by this Court on 23.10.2019. The second petition bearing CRM-M No. 18760 of 2020 was dismissed by this Court on 13.08.2020. The petitioner has been attributed a 'datar' blow on the eyebrow of the complainant. Therefore, he

does not deserve the concession of anticipatory bail.

Consequently, the petition stands dismissed.
