This petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.29 dated 27.02.2019, under Section 21 (4) (1) Mines and Minerals Act, 1957 & Section 379 Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Partap Nagar, District Yamuna Nagar. The petitioner apprehended his arrest at the hands of Police, in the above FIR.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has invited the attention of the Court to the order dated 02.03.2020, whereby, while issuing notice of motion to respondent-State, the interim protection was extended to the petitioner. The said order reads as under:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the FIR was lodged against many screening plants, including the plant of petitioner, i.e., M/s

Bansal Screening Plant. He further contents that Imran the proprietor of M/s Isran Screening Plant has been granted interim protection by the High Court in CRM-M-70-2020 on 08.01.2020.

Notice of motion for 18.05.2020.

Interim order in the same terms as passed in CRM-M70-2020.

To be heard along with CRM-M-70-2020.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner further contends that in deference to the said order, the petitioner submitted himself before the Police and joined the investigation. According to him, the petitioner cooperated with the Police Authorities during the investigation and furnished requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer.

Learned State counsel, who is assisted by ASI Lakhvinder Masih does not dispute this fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation for the time being.

Considering the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 02.03.2020 is made absolute.
