JAISHREE THAKUR, J. (Oral)

This petition has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 214, dated 01.12.2020 under Sections 406, 498-A IPC, registered at Police Station Samrala, District Khanna, Punjab.

Learned counsel for the petitioner would contend that the petitioner is the mother-in-law and due to temperamental differences between the complainant and petitioner's son, she has been falsely implicated in the present case. It is further submitted that in terms of the order dated 24.03.2021 passed in CRM-M-13547-2021, an amount of Rs.10 lakhs has already been deposited by the petitioner's son before the

trial Court and has been disbursed to the complainant against security. It is further contended that nothing is to be recovered from the petitioner herein.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and have perused the paper book.

In view of the facts that the matter has been investigated qua the petitioner and she has joined the investigation, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 16.03.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
